



Have kids repeat after you. "Thank You God that you fight my battles. Help me with _____. I trust You to take care of me and the battles that I face. In Jesus name, amen!"



Talk with the kids about how God will make a way even when there looks like there is no way. Share with the kids about a time that God made a way for you in your life.





As leader holds a basket of oyster crackers, say: "Let's pretend this is manna and we are the Israelites collecting our manna for the day." Each child will get a small Dixie cup. Pour out the oyster crackers on the table and have kids collect the crackers to fill their cups. Say "God gave the people of Israel food every day and He'll make sure you have food too."



Have kids act like birds and fly around like the quail that God provided for the Israelites. Play worship music in the background and even play freeze dance style!








What is one rule that you follow every day? God gave us rules to help us know the best way to live. These rules are called the Ten Commandments.

10 Commandments Pop-up Example

Instructions

- 1. Fold paper in half with the dashed lines showing and cut the dashed lines.
- 2. Unfold paper and push out the 1-inch cuts and fold along line to make a "box". You may need to fold the paper again to get the "box" to fold.
- 3. Have children glue the mountain in the background and the tablets to the "box" where it says, "Glue here."







Talk with the kids about why we worship God and what are some ways we can worship Him.



Now that the Israelites are free from Egypt and were given the 10 Commandments, God wanted to have a place for the people to worship Him. He told Moses to build a tabernacle for the tablets to stay in and a place for the people to worship. Every time the Israelites moved, they had to pack up the tabernacle and move it with them. Talk with the kids about the different areas of the tabernacle and what you would do in each section.



Have kids repeat after you. "Thank You God that we can worship You anytime and we are now the tabernacle where Jesus lives in us! We love You. In Jesus name, amen!





Have kids repeat after you. "Thank You God that You are the one true God. There are no other gods but You. I want to keep you first in my life. In Jesus name, amen!"







Have kids play follow the leader like the Israelites did in the dessert when they followed the pillar of cloud (God).







Talk to the kids about how they had to ask for forgiveness before Jesus came. Talk about the Hight Priest breastplate and how each stone represented a tribe of Israel.



Aaron was Moses' brother and God made him the first priest. It was his job to make sacrifices for the people to God for forgiveness of their sins. Now, we have Jesus who is the perfect sacrifice (on the cross) and we don't have to sacrifice animals anymore. All we have to do is ask Jesus to forgive us and turn away from our sins (bad choices). Isn't that amazing!




